Delete existing paragraph **Estimate of Managed Available Groundwater**, page 18, and replace with following text:

### **Estimate of Modeled Available Groundwater**

GAM Run 10-030 MAG, 22 June 2011, Table 7, provides the total pumping values for Gaines County for the Ogallala/Edwards-Trinity Aquifer systems (units are acre-feet per year). These values are the equivalent of the Modeled Available Groundwater.

### **Amendment # 2:**

Delete existing paragraph 12.0, **Desired Future Conditions of the Aquifers** page 25, and replace with following text:

### **Goal 12.0 Desired Future Conditions of the Aquifers**

Desired Future Conditions (DFCs) were adopted in August 2010. The adopted values (units are feet of drawdown from the 2008 level) are:

**12.01** The Ogallala/Trinity-Edwards Aquifer System: Average Drawdown less than 70 feet in 2060.

Ogallala/Trinity -Edwards System:	5	27	41	53	63	70

The average drawdown values were extracted from GAM Task 10-23, Table 11.

**12.02** The Dockum Aquifer: Average Drawdown less than 40 feet overall average in GMA 2, based on Table A-8, GAM Task 10-025, 10 June, 2010. The drawdown values for Gaines County/Llano Estacado UWCD (units are feet of drawdown from the 2008 level) are as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of the District have determined that a Amendment of the existing Management Plan is warranted; and




**RESOLVED**, that the Board of Directors of the Llano Estacado Underground Water Conservation District hereby adopt the Amendment to The Management Plan; and further


